ABOUT THE BOAT:

Dragon class sailboat designed by Norwegian Johan Anker in 1928 Wood - constructed at Lee Bay, Pender Harbour by her owner between 2000 - 2006 with generous advice provided by the late Tom Barker, Zorro Szabados and Bob Fielding

DESIGN:

115 HP (1950)

REPLACEMENT ENGINE:

Cold-moulded hull over White Oak keelsom and ribs, four layers of African mahogany planks run horizontally and mahogany plywood strips run diagonally. 6 coats of epoxy and 10 coats of Inter-lux Golden Spar varnish

RESTORATION:

Sitka spruce mast is set in a pulpit on the deck to allow lowering for trailering, seats made from Western Maple harvested at Lee Bay Cockpit enlarged by a foot to allow installation of inboard 5 HP Honda engine.

TIDBIT:

Won division title in the 2009 Malaspina Regatta; won Judges Overall at the 2008 Sunshine Coast Wooden Boat Festival.
