45' 11' 3" beam. Built by Hoffar-Beeching Shipyards in Coal Harbour, Vancouver in 1929. 6-cylinder Isuzu engine.

RESTORATION:

Extensive re-fits in 2006 and 2009, including new wheelhouse, planking and deck.

1928 – 1949 Government of British Columbia, Attorney General, BC Provincial Police

1950 – 1959 Royal Canadian Mounted Police

1961 – 1967 A. L. Miller, Victoria

1968 – 1971 David Carson, White Rock

1972 – 2001 Benbro Marine Leasing Co. Ltd., Vancouver

2004 Ben Keoughan, Madeira Park purchased the boat from Don Benson, Madeira Park.

TIDBIT:

Formerly a BC Provincial Police Patrol boat that carried prisoners to the New Westminster courthouse from various coastal communities north of Vancouver. Became an RCMP vessel in 1950 when the force took over Provincial Police marine assets.
