### DESIGNER AND BUILDER:

Barrie Farrell ~ 1968. Built for Frank Beal from Egmont. Barrie built the boat in the big A-frame building that Vic Gooldrup had behind our very own Garden Bay Pub. Either Frank or someone else built the deck you see on her now.

### HISTORY:

Barrie built a 16' fiberglass over plywood boat for himself and later took a mold off of it to build this boat and several others like it. His many boats were recognized for their gracefully flared bows.

### GOOD STORY:

Barrie has built over 300 boats and the early use of fiberglass made his boats faster. His fishing boats dominated the B.C. salmon fleet in the 1970s and 1980s.
