HISTORY:

Owner and builder James Roberts is the grandson of "Founding Spirit of the Sunshine Coast", Harry Roberts. Harry was the patron saint of Roberts Creek. While living there, he built the Chack Chack between 1917 and 1920.

Later in life, Harry resettled on a paradisiacal south-facing beach at Cape Cockburn on nearby Nelson Island where he constructed his celebrated second home, "Sunray". Harry's Cockburn Bay property and home is now a regional park on Nelson Island.

James continues his grandfather Harry Roberts' boatbuilding tradition with this beautiful little boat.
