30ft Cruiser, built at Granville Island in 1947. Designed by Ed Monk, built by H.E Snider. Red cedar below the waterline, yellow cedar above and mahogany cabin. The engine was replaced in the mid-70s with a 6 cylinder Chrysler-Nissan diesel.

RENOVATIONS:

2017 – Underwent full re-caulking and refastening by present owner, along with two new planks. Interior is mostly unchanged from the original layout.
