

Rick's "FINE"

OWNER:

Rick Crook Oyster Bay Boats

DESIGN:

"Fine" is the model name for a sliding seat rowboat, which is a re-design of Dave Gentry's boat "Ruth", a skin-on frame boat.

This Fine is a is a cedar-strip hull covered with fiberglass cloth and epoxy.

ABOUT THE BOAT:

It is 18 feet loa by 34 inch beam, red and yellow cedar with beech trim. All up weight is about 80 lbs. The rigger and sliding seat frame can be removed to leave a 55 lb hull that can be carried by one person.

HISTORY:

This is Rick's personal boat, which he regularly rows around Pender Harbour. It is 4 years old and currently moored here at Madeira Park Dock for Pender Harbour Days for visitors to try out. TIDBIT: Sliding seats allow the rower to use their leg muscles to move the boat.
