DESIGNER AND BUILDER:

John Harstock was the original designer of the Cosine Wherry. It is 14 feet overall, with a 54 inch beam. Can easily maintain 3.5 knots when rowed solo, and yet has a capacity of 550 lbs at the design waterline. The cedar strip process brings the weight to about 90 pounds, so two people can move it from a vehicle to the water.
