### ABOUT THE BOAT:

An 18' Skookum Salty designed by Bill Garden. Built 1972 by Philbrook's Boatyard near Victoria.

Fiberglass with 500 lb concrete keel and original 10 hp cast iron Briggs engine.

Inside and outside steering. Small table with original chart of fishing area. V-area where you can sleep. 500 lbs in keel makes it a very stable boat.

### HISTORY:

10 were built for day charter boats out of Brentwood Bay (Vancouver Island) in 1972. The fleet was painted yellow. This one, Yew II (3 G's), was owned by Geisbrecht family, owner of the company.

### TIDBIT:

**Skookum Salty is the tender for the Western Yew. There were only 10 built for day charter boats out of Brentwood Bay.**
