### ABOUT THE BOAT:

20' 7'3" beam Wood – later fiberglass

### BUILT:

Built in 1963 by Don Penson, Wee One was commissioned by the Cameron family for use as a herring skiff for local fishing and bait delivery around Pender Harbour. Barrie Farrell added a wheelhouse in late '60's or early '70's.

### ENGINE:

Volvo 4 cyl. gas engine

### RESTORATION:

Restoration work includes electrical, hull, repainting, hydraulics, lights, windows, exhaust, signage by Mardyn Signs – completed in 2006
