We have lots in store for you starting with our boat parade around the harbour Friday evening (google map available at <http://www.penderharbour.ca/parade-map.html>) at 5:30 pm, followed with a performance by local musicians at the nearby School of Music with the doors open at 7:30 pm.

The on shore marine festival events start on Saturday at 10:00 am and your boats will be the hit of the weekend. Additionally, there will be many artisan and craft booths and lots of fun kids' activities throughout the day. Many small, traditional wood boats will also be on display on land. A hard hat diving display, firehall display, astronomy daytime telescope demo, and many other events and venues will be available as well on Saturday. Rest up at the end of the day for we have evening entertainment with a Prime Rib Dinner and Dance at our local legion (7:00 – 11:00 PM) and Nikki Weber & Friends jazz concert at the Pender Harbour School of Music (7:00 – 9:00 PM).

Sunday starts off with a Lions Club breakfast followed by a Heritage Presentation at the School of Music featuring Guest Speaker Isaac van der Horst. His talk will include mention of the Scandinavians of the Harbour. The Rotarians will again host a lunch barbeque near the marina office. We wind down with closing ceremonies at 2:00 PM held at the Outdoor Classroom and include drawing the winner of the Canoe Raffle and 50/50 Draw.
